Here We Go 'Round the Mulberry Bush

The adult sings the verse and gives the correct hand motion for the original verse, but changes the object of the verb to a word that does not fit with the hand motion.

The child has to stop the adult at the end of the verse and give the correct word.

For example, the adult should sing the verse below while doing the "wash our clothes" hand motion (pretending to wash clothes on a washboard):

This is the way we wash our grass, wash our grass, wash our grass, This is the way we wash our grass,
So early Monday morning.

OTHER SUBSTITUTIONS:

iron our hair — while pretending to iron clothes scrub our milk — while pretending to scrub face with washcloth mend our eggs — while pretending to sew with needle and thread sweep the plants — while pretending to sweep with a broom bake our toys — while pretending to put something in an oven go to bathe — while holding hands together as if in prayer
