

# The Wheels on the Bus

## ALTERED VERSION

The adult sings the verse and gives the correct hand motion for the original word, but the wrong sound. The child has to stop the adult at the end of the verse and give the correct noise to match the word and hand motion.

For example, the adult should sing the verse below while doing the “round and round” arm motion:

The wheels on the bus go  
beep, beep, beep;  
beep, beep, beep;  
beep, beep, beep.  
The wheels on the bus go  
beep, beep, beep,  
All through the town!

The child should correct the adult by saying the noise should be “round and round” instead of “beep beep beep.”

The adult can do multiple verses of this song, with a different word-noise mismatch in each verse.
